

BE OF GOOD CHEER

We've heard it again and again: Change is inevitable.

Small changes creep up on us. (Thirty years later, I realize that the 90's haircut I thought was lovely and "forever" is long-since gone, that glasses now live permanently on my nose, that I probably never will pick up violin-playing again ...)

Big changes can "throw us for a loop" and are more difficult to handle: the shock of divorce, the loneliness of empty nest, the pain of health issues, the sorrow of death, devastating natural disasters, the responsibility of human-caused disasters...

In the life of our congregation, changes are here:

In the last six months, a few of us have interviewed and hired two different custodians, and three different office assistants. The investment in time and training has been significant, but we have moved into a good and supportive working environment and feel blessed to be in this place.

Our pastor, Debbie Roberts, who (like many of the rest of us) has chosen to move towards retirement, and so leaves us permanently at the end of April. We say a BIG thank-you to Debbie (and Steve) for being a grace-filled leader in our midst. Your scholarship, compassion, and fun-loving spirits will be missed!

At our Sunrise service on April 21, pastors Debbie Roberts (Sunnyslope) and David Morrow (Wenatchee Brethren Baptist Church), reflected that one of the clear messages of the resurrection narrative is that *nothing is ever final*. In spite of the very worst thing the disciples could imagine happening (Jesus' crucifixion), <u>Easter morning came</u>, and the light of God shined back into their lives.
