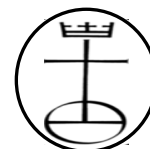

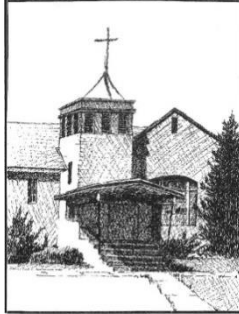

Wenatchee Area Neighbors for Immigrant Justice Rights

A new group is being formed for the purpose of promoting a community of neighbors who support immigrant rights in the greater Wenatchee area. The *Wenatchee Area Neighbors for Immigrant Justice Rights* (or WEN Neighbors) is a part of the statewide network of immigrant rights groups under the umbrella of the Washington Immigration Solidarity Network (www.waisn.org).

WEN Neighbors will work to

- Network among and support established local organizations that are effectively operating within our community (NWIRP, Hand in Hand, CAFÉ, Parque Padrinos and others)
- Through WA Immigrant Solidarity Network, respond to Rapid Response and Accompaniment calls, provide *Know Your Rights* trainings and family support for undocumented immigrants at risk of detention.
- Promote and support relationships and facilitate bridge-building between culturally diverse communities
- Advocate for just immigration policies statewide and nationally
- Give voice to those who are most impacted by the immigration situation in our community

The group will participate in a variety of activities from supporting families with food and other necessities to recruiting and training volunteers to accompany people navigating the pipelines of the immigration machine; to their immigration hearings, ICE check-ins, and civil courthouse matters.

The group meets the 4th Monday of the month in the evenings (location varies). The next meeting is **September 23, 2019 at 6:30 p.m.** (Location to be determined.) A training will be provided for those who are interested in being a part of the Accompaniment System. You do not have to speak Spanish to be a participate in this system.
